(hereinafter Expo) and by the European Commission/Joint Research Centre (JRC) (hereinafter “*European Commission*”), and by **Ciessevi Association - Centre for Voluntary Service – Città Metropolitana di Milano** (hereinafter “*Ciessevi*”), within the limits of their official duties and activities in relation to the Program “Volunteers for EU Pavilion” (hereinafter “Volunteers Program”) in compliance with the basic principles laid down in the Personal Data Protection Code (Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003 and subsequent amendments or additions) and in Regulation n. 45/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (General Data Protection Regulation)

Processing of personal data and relative purposes

We wish to inform you that your data and eventually the email address entered in registering for the Volunteers Program and any other information connected to you gathered during the registration will be used for the following purposes: a) registration and evaluation of application of the minor and his profile for the Volunteers Program; b) necessary activities for the preparation, organization and execution of the Volunteers Program; c) compliance with the obligations imposed by laws or regulations; d) mailing of communications regarding the Volunteer Program.

Freedom of giving consent and consequences of refusal

Your consent to the processing and treatment of personal information is necessary. The only consequence of refusing to give your consent is the failure to take part in the Volunteers Program. To achieve purposes above indicated, your personal details will be communicated, transmitted to, or processed by third parties contributors for Expo, for the European Commission and Ciessevi, which will operate according to the rules prescribed by the law on the protection of personal data. Your personal data may also be sent to the judicial authorities or supervisory control bodies if required by law or regulations or if requested by legitimate orders. In no event your personal data will be disseminated indiscriminately.

Rights (Article 7, Leg. Dec. 196/03)

We remind you that Art. 7 of the Privacy Law gives you various entitlements, including the right to obtain confirmation of the existence or not of personal data and to know its content and its origin, to check its accuracy and ask for it to be added, updated, amended or deleted if in violation of the law. You may exercise these rights at any time or change the data supplied.

Unfaithful registration

Expo, the European Commission and Ciessevi understand that Volunteers Program may be of interest also to minors, but the Program is reserved for persons who have attained the age of majority at the time of participation in the Volunteers Program. Therefore, Expo, the European Commission and Ciessevi invite persons exercising the parental authority to monitor the use of the Internet by minor, for a safe and filtered use of its contents, including through the use of parental control tools, in order to also prevent disclosure of personal data by minor which do not have the consent of exercising parental authority. In any event, Expo, the

European Commission and Ciessevi do not perform any operation for the treatment of personal data of minors without prior approval of persons exercising the parental authority and cannot be responsible for the transfer of personal data from minors. Expo, the European Commission and Ciessevi reserve the right to deny access to the Volunteers Program to any minor users who has hidden their own age or who have disclose their personal data, even if minor, not having the consent of exercising parental authority.
